Ecuador is one of the many importing countries of ammonium nitrate, the chemical compound for agricultural use that due to its mismanagement caused a catastrophic explosion in the Port of Beirut, in Lebanon. In the Latin American country, cargo enters through the different Ports of Guayaquil, which ensure that the appropriate measures are implemented to avoid accidents such as the one that occurred in the Asian country.



Port of Guayaquil, Ecuador: Andipuerto dispatched more than 170 thousand tons of cargo in July 2020"

About 18 thousand tons correspond to general cargo and another 152 thousand tons belong to bulk cargo. Of this total, 18,158.75 tons correspond to general cargo, such as hot steel coils, cold steel and galvanized steel; galvalumen, galvanized, zinc and aluzinc coils; hot slabs; hot steel and cold steel plates; hot iron bundles; and rails to the cities of Cuenca, Machala, Quito and Guayaquil.

ECLAC: ECUADOR ONE OF THE PORTS THAT INCREASED ACTIVITY DURING THE PANDEMIC

IThe latest report from the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC) on the effects of the coronavirus (Covid-19) on international trade and logistics showed that the region's ports have suffered significant losses in the mobilization of containerized cargo At world level, maritime trade by containers has followed a downward trend and in the case of Latin America the variation between January and May was -6.1%, showing marked decreases in April and May. Ports with increases in activity On the other hand, the ports in the region that showed the greatest increases in container activity were two terminals on the Pacific coast of Panama with an increase of 39%, three terminals on the Caribbean coast of Panama with a growth of 14.0%, the Bay of Cartagena (Colombia) that registered an increase of 11.7% and Rosario (Argentina) that presented an increase of 10.5%. Meanwhile, the ports that presented moderate increases were Paranaguá in Brazil (9.3%), Itapoá in Brazil (8.1%), Santos in Brazil (7.1%), Zárate in Argentina (3.2%), Guayaquil in Ecuador (2.6%)





ABC SHIPPING CO AND THE EFFECTS OF THE BEIRUT EXPLOSION

fter over a decade of freight forwarding customs brokerage, ABC shipping Co. was founded in the heart of Beirut city the capital of Lebanon, and main gate for all import and export shipments in Lebanon. Operated with the experience of the owners, and the outstanding staff, ABC rapidly books its position in the local market as one of the leader freight forwarders and customs brokerage.

Unfortunately, due to unseen circumstances, our businesses was suddenly greatly affected. The August 4 Beirut Port explosion is a historical disaster that hit Lebanon's economic hub, leaving behind it a massive human and economic loss. Due to negligence,

large amounts of ammonium nitrate were stored in a hangar in the port of the city of Beirut, causing at least 181 deaths, 6,000 injuries, US\$10–15 billion in property damage, and leaving an estimated 300,000 people homeless. This blast only added insult to injury to the economic depression Lebanon has been going through the past year, and with the destruction of the port, import and export activities were also gravely hurt.




The Beirut port occupies around 70% of all Lebanese imports and exports (including the airport and land borders). However the port occupies 90% of all port imports, so the other ports aren't as effective or strong contenders or replacements. They're smaller and unable to sustain imports coming in. The Tripoli port is around 3 sq km and occupies around 10% of Lebanese imports. The others (The Tyre one for example) are significantly smaller. Around 60% of the Beirut port's capacity has been lost and the other ports aren't sufficient enough to absorb this deficit.

Fortunately, there is a silver lining. The container receiving part of the port remained intact and has been in use. Beirut Port Container Terminal resumed work on August 10

Beirut Harbor resumed reception of ships starting 10 August 2020. Container ships and RoRo ships are also now able to dock on some of the sidewalks. In the meantime however, major cargo imports are changing route to the Tripoli port, which ABC Shipping is following up with

Panama Canal celebrates 106 years with its validity strengthened

The Panama Canal reached its 106 years of operation on August 15, with its validity strengthened in the midst of an unprecedented health crisis. Its role as a facilitator of world trade has allowed it to guarantee a continuous and safe service during the current pandemic, and at the same time,



keep the North in its main challenge for the future: water.

Just a few weeks ago, on Monday, August 10th, reaching 10,000 transits through the expanded Canal since its opening four years ago, the interoceanic highway reaffirmed its role in the global supply chain.

"The events of this week: our 10,000th Neopanamax transit and the 106th anniversary, mark new milestones that reaffirm the competitiveness of the Panama Canal, backed by a continuous, safe and reliable service," said administrator Ricaurte Vasquez Morales.

In the midst of the current pandemic, the Panama Canal has maintained its regular operations, reinforcing its sanitary and security protocols to allow the constant transport of essential goods and contribute to promoting the post-Covid-19 economic reactivation.

The Panama Canal closely follows the changes facing the markets to be prepared and take advantage of opportunities. For example, an approach from manufacturing centers to consumption centers resulting in the restructuring and regionalization of global supply chains.

This dynamics would drive greater traffic of larger and heavier ships that transport bulk and dry cargo through the Panama Canal, stressing the importance of ensuring an operational water level that meets customer needs.

Towards the future: water

This market projection reaffirms the efforts of the Panama Canal to find a long-term solution for the availability of water in the Gatun and Alhajuela lakes, which, between them, supply half of the country's population, and feed the main natural resource for the operation of the road.

As a result, of the climate crisis, in 2019, the Panama Canal Watershed experienced its fifth driest year in 70 years, with less rainfall, causing lake levels to drop well below average.

Having this into consideration, the Canal acted by implementing measures such as a charge for fresh water that came into effect last February, in addition to water conservation practices that had been in place months before.

These measures made it possible to maintain a stable draft despite the lack of rain in 2019. As a result, the road was able to offer a draft of 48 feet, the highest in more than 12 months.

The Panama Canal continues its search for long-term solutions and hopes to identify a comprehensive portfolio of projects aimed at strengthening the water resources management efforts of the Watershed by 2021.



egular WB Hefei – Helsinki and EB Helsinki – Hefei route have been proved reliable and fast link between China and Skandinavia. Both WB and EB trains have been stable with average transit time 14 days during the hole spring and this summer.

Instead on the New Silk Route main corridor at the Belarus – Poland EU border grossing WB trains from China runs delay in average 7 – 10 days. Delays have been regular over the longer period of time during this summer. The delays are said to be due to increased number of trains, last two week there have been unstable political situation in Belarus. Last two weeks have been increasingly slow and trains have spent more than week to grossing the Belarus, which usually takes less than 24 hours.

Link to China via Helsinki could be interesting option for time critical shipments for Western Europe shipments. Cut off time in Helsinki is also shorter than in main European rail hubs. Port of Helsinki is well connected to Western Europe main ports with daily ro-ro ferry service. ProStar Logistics have more than 4 years' experience of regular


